

DR. S. SOMANATH

Dr. S. Somanath, the 10th Chairman of Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO), achieved a significant milestone with Chandrayaan-3, making India the fourth Country to land on the Moon and the First Country in the World to perform a soft land on the South Pole of the Moon. Born in 1963 in Thuravoor, Kerala, Dr. Somanath holds a B.Tech. in Mechanical Engineering from TKM College of Engineering, and Master's degree in Aerospace Engineering with a 'Gold Medal' from IISc, Bangalore and an Honorary Doctorate of Science from SRM Institute of Science and Technology in 2022. Before his role as ISRO Chairman, Dr. Somanath served as the Director of VSSC and the Director of the LPSC in Thiruvananthapuram. He specializes in system engineering and architecture of launch vehicles. He is a distinguished member of Indian National Academy of Engineering (INAE), the Aeronautical Society of India (AeSI), the Astronautical Society of India (ASI), and serves as a Corresponding Member of the International Academy of Astronautics (IAA). His remarkable achievements include the 'Space Gold Medal' from the Astronautical Society of India, 'Merit Award,' and 'Performance Excellence Award' from ISRO, 'National Aeronautics Prize' from the Aeronautical Society of India (ASI) as well. Dr. S. Somanath, is currently the Vikram Sarabhai Distinguished Professor at ISRO, Distinguished Visiting Professor, IISc, Bangalore and Advisor (Space Technology) Andhra Pradesh Government.



MR. A. V. JONES

Mr. A. V. Jones alias Georgekutty who instituted the award was born in Melpadom, a village in Alapuzha District. After completing his school and college education, he migrated to Singapore in the year 1953 and worked there in different capacities till 1994. Mr. Jones was always interested in promoting scientific and technical studies and also helped bright children among the weaker sections of the society to continue their studies, particularly in the field of scientific research. He was a philanthropist and set apart a substantial portion of his savings towards these charitable purposes. He passed away after a successful life at the age of 96 on 8th April 2025.
